**A. CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Tudyk called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Rev Ralph Reitmeyer gave the invocation.

**C. PUBLIC COMMENTS CONCERNING MATTERS NOT ON THE AGENDA**


#### **E. Future Council Agenda Items.**
