A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS ESTABLISHING FULL SUPPORT OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE VALLEY SPRINGS AREA FOR A MUNICIPAL WELL FIELD FOR THE CITY OF LLANO AS A PRIME LOCATION TO PROVIDE A RELIABLE SOURCE OF GROUND WATER

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Llano realize the weather pattern of the area has created a drought of record; and

WHEREAS, the City of Llano is dependent on the Llano River for the sole source of water; and

WHEREAS, the need for an alternate source of water is evident; and

WHEREAS, the development of a ground water source is the most feasible resource available; and

WHEREAS, A subcommittee has identified an aquifer in the Valley Springs area as a possible site for a municipal well field; and

WHEREAS, preliminary studies have verified the Valley Springs area as a prime location to provide a reliable source of ground water.

WHEREAS, the Resolution was duly introduced for consideration of said City Council, was then duly moved and seconded that said Resolution be passed; and, after due discussion, said motion, carrying with it the passage of said Resolution, prevailed and carried by the following vote:


