*WHEREAS, Cobbler is also paired with another Texas-born favorite, Blue Bell Ice Cream; and*

*WHEREAS, Llano has created a cobbler competition as part of its Blue Bell Bluegrass Festival to celebrate and continue this delicious baked dessert; and*

*WHEREAS, no other Texas town to has embraced Cobbler with such enthusiasm and pride to keep this traditional Texas cooking legacy alive; and*

*THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED this Resolution was duly introduced for consideration of said City Council, was then duly moved and seconded that said Resolution be passed; said motion, carrying with it the passage of said Resolution naming*

***Llano as the "Cobbler Capital of Texas"***

*and extend to the residents and festival attendees sincere best wishes for continued success in their maintenance of a proud Llano and Texas tradition.*
