A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A PERFORMANCE STATEMENT MODIFICATION/AMENDMENT TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENTOF AGRICULTURE CONTRACT, TEXAS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT CONTRACT NO. 712127, DISASTER RELIEF FUND PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Agriculture awarded to the City of Llano a Texas Community Development Block Grant, Contract No. 712127 for the Disaster Relief Fund in support of water well development as an alternative source of water supply;

WHEREAS, the City recently determined that low river flows is causing the six month water supply (water impounded by the dam) to be stagnant rendering the current water treatment process ineffective;

WHEREAS, the drought is continuing to worsen and the City is on six month deadline, to provide water before the summer season;

WHEREAS, the City of Llano is proposing a water treatment process to make use of the impounded water and alluvial water development within the available funds;

WHERAS, the City of Llano has complied with the Texas Community Development Block grant program requirement by conducting a public hearing to discuss the proposed performance statement modification/amendment to the Texas Community Development Block Grant Contract No. 712127.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS:

The Mayor is hereby authorized to submit a performance statement modification/amendment to the Texas Department of Agriculture Contract No. 712127 to provide for (1) completion of an alluvial water well(s) located along the embankment of the Llano River (2) install pretreatment facilities at the existing water plant to reduce total organic carbon (TOC) concentrations levels in the impounded raw water supply during drought a period due to low flow conditions in the Llano River. All of the improvements will take place on city owned property.
