

RESOLUTION 2013-03-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF LLANO AUTHORIZING THE FRIENDS OF THE LLANO RED TOP JAIL TO USE SALVAGED MATERIALS FROM THE RED TOP JAIL FOR FUNDRAISING TO BENEFIT THE RESTORATION OR OPERATION OF THE RED TOP JAIL BUILDING OR FOR REPURPOSING FOR USE IN THE RED TOP JAIL BUILDING.

WHEREAS, the mission of the Friends of the Llano Red Top Jail, a 501(c)(3) organization, is to help the City of Llano with fundraising, historical research, community awareness and definition of an appropriate function for this historical structure; and

WHEREAS, construction materials in the building may be removed during restoration and no longer needed in the building; and

WHEREAS, these materials may be salvaged and used for fundraising purposes for the building's restoration or operation or repurposed for use in the operation of the building; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned uses are considered by this City Council to serve a public purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY AS FOLLOWS:

The Friends of the Llano Red Top Jail have the permission of the City of Llano City Council to use salvaged materials from the Llano Red Top Jail building for fundraising for the direct benefit of or repurposing for use in the operation of the Llano Red Top Jail building.
