

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-03-21

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING PRESIDING JUDGE AND ALTERNATE JUDGE FOR THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 14, 2011 FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO ALDERMEN AND ONE MAYOR FOR THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, FOR THE EARLY VOTING PRESIDING JUDGE AND ALTERNATE JUDGE AND EARLY VOTING BALLOT BOARD PRESIDING JUDGE AND ALTERNATE JUDGE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS HEREBY RESOLVES:

SECTION I

Stephen Cowey is hereby appointed to serve as the Presiding Judge of said general election early voting and Carole Leeder as the Alternate Judge of said general election early voting to be held at 102 E. Haynie, Llano, Texas 78643, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. beginning on May 2, 2011 and ending on May 10, 2011. To comply with House Bill 2309, requiring early voting to take place for at least 12 hours on two weekdays; on Monday, May 2, 2011, and Monday, May 9, 2011 early voting by personal appearance will be conducted between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. The presiding judge shall appoint no more than two (2) qualified election clerks to serve and assist in conducting said elections, providing that, if the Presiding Judge actually serves as expected, the Alternate Presiding Judge shall be one of such clerks.

SECTION II.

Betty Smith is hereby appointed to serve as the Early Voting Ballot Board Presiding Judge and Joyce Foster as the Alternate Judge.

SECTION III.

Kathy Pinckney is hereby appointed to serve as the Presiding Judge of said general election day voting and Carole Leeder the Alternate Judge of said general election day voting at Llano County Library, 102 East Haynie, Llano, Texas 78643. The polling place shall be kept open from seven o'clock a.m. until seven o'clock p.m. on May 14, 2011.

SECTION IV.

It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was adopted was open to the public and public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given, all as required by Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.

SECTION V.

This resolution shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, and it is so resolved.
