
WHEREAS, the City desires to support the construction and installation of fiber optic technology; and determines the construction and installation of this technology provides a vital public service; and

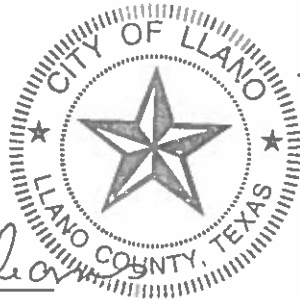
