

ORDINANCE NO. 1436

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, CHAPTER 26, ARTICLE II, SECTION 26-33 AND PEDDLERS AND SOLICITORS; AND PROVIDING FOR THE FOLLOWING: FINDINGS OF FACT; ENACTMENT; REPEALER; SEVERABILITY; PUBLICATION; EFFECTIVE DATE; AND PROPER NOTICE AND MEETING.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas ("City Council") adopted regulations concerning peddlers and vendors within the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Section 51.001, the City has general authority to adopt an ordinance or police regulation that is for the good government, peace or order of the City and is necessary or proper for carrying out a power granted by law to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens to regulate peddlers and vendors as setout herein;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS:

Section 1. Findings. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Code Amended. Chapter 26, Business, Article II, Peddlers and Solicitors, Section 26-33 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Llano, Texas is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Sec. 26-33. License required; exceptions.

(8) One Million Dollar per Occurrence, with a Two Million Dollar Aggregate General Liability Insurance Policy

(9) Payment of the following appropriate license fee said fee to be set in accordance with section 1-14 of this Code:

- a. One day.
- b. One week.
- c. Ninety days.
- d. One year.

Section 3. Repealer Clause. All provisions of the ordinances of the City of Llano in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of

such conflict, and all other provisions of the ordinances of the City of Llano not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Severability Clause. Should any sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of the Code of Ordinances as a whole.


Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provide.

Section 6. Proper Notice and Meeting. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Ordinance was adopted was open to the public and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code.
