AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL AMENDING ORDINANCE 737 APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE CITY OF LLANO EMPLOYEE MANUAL AND POLICY MANUAL AS PREPARED BY THE CITY MANAGER AND STAFF; REPEALING ALL OTHER ORDINANCES OR PORTIONS THEREOF IN CONFLICT.

ORDINANCE 1243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 1086; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL TO AMEND AND/OR ADJUST RATES BY RESOLUTION FOR THE USE OF THE LLANO MUNICIPAL AIRPORT HANGARS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Llano has expressed a desire wishing to amend and or adjust rates by Resolution for the City of Llano Municipal Airport; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of a municipality may adopt, publish, amend, or repeal an ordinance, rule, or police regulation that is for the good of the government, peace, or order of the municipality;

WHEREAS, the municipality may adopt an ordinance, act, law, or regulation, not inconsistent with state law, that is necessary for the government, interest, welfare, or good order of the municipality as a body politic.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LLANO, TEXAS;

That the City Council of Llano hereby be authorized by resolution to amend and/or adjust rates of the Llano Municipal Airport Hangars, and that this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
