

ORDINANCE NO. 1245

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY SPECIAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 11, 2013.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas called an election for City Officers to be held in the City on May 11, 2013, for one (1) Councilmember to be elected to an unexpired term of one year.

WHEREAS, immediately after said election the Presiding Judge and other officials holding said election made the returns of the results thereof to the City Council as set forth herein, and said returns being made according to law, and duly authenticated, being shown that written notice of said election was posted for the time and manner provided by law, and all other proceedings pertaining to said election have been shown to have been done and performed at and within the manner provided by law, and all papers pertaining thereto having been returned and filed with the City Council and no protest or objection being made to or regarding any manner pertaining to said election;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That after examining the returns of the Municipal Election held in the City on May 11, 2013, and opening and canvassing the votes of said election that the results of said Special election are as follows:

SECTION 2. That said special election was duly called, that notice of said election was given in accordance with law, and that said special election was held in accordance with the law, and that Allen Hopson was duly elected Alderman, to an unexpired term of one year. That the above named parties are hereby declared duly elected to those respective offices, subject to the taking of their oaths as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

SECTION 3. That this Canvass and Declaration of Results of Election be entered in the minutes of the City Council and that said officers, after being qualified and having taken the oath, shall serve during the term commencing May 20, 2013 and thereafter until a successor is duly elected and qualified.

SECTION 4. It is further found and determined that in accordance with the order of the governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located in the City Hall, a place convenient and readily accessible to the general public, and said notice having been so posted and remaining posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the scheduled time of said meeting.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
