ORDINANCE NO. 1463

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LLANO APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE GENERAL FUND AND UTILITY FUND BUDGETS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2021, AND ENDING ON SEPTEMBER 30, 2022.

WHEREAS, on September 20, 2021, the City Council of the City of Llano (Council) adopted Ordinance No. 1450 approving a budget for the current fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines it is prudent to amend the budget due to unforeseen conditions that have occurred in the City; and

WHEREAS, circumstances have arisen during the fiscal year which have, or will, require the expenditure of additional funds in some of the line items in the budget, and for which there is more than adequate funding in other line items of the budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Council now finds it in the best interest of the City of Llano and its residents to amend the adopted budget for the General Fund and Utility Fund as set forth in respective Exhibits "A" based on the review and analysis provided by the Finance Director.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS:

I.

That the City Council of the City of Llano hereby approves the General Fund and Utility Fund budget amendments for the current fiscal year beginning October 1, 2021, and ending September 30, 2022, attached hereto as Exhibits "A".

II.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication, as may be required by law.

III.

Should any part of this Ordinance be declared invalid, for any reason, such invalidity shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.

III.


