

RESOLUTION NO. R-2022-14

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, ADOPTING A YEAR MORATORIUM ON THE VACATION, ABANDONMENT, OR CLOSURE OF A CITY STREET OR ALLEY.

Whereas, the City of Llano, Texas (“City”), is a Texas Type A general law municipality; and

Whereas, pursuant to Texas Transportation Code § 311.002, the City has exclusive control over the highways, streets, and alleys of the City; and

Whereas, pursuant to Texas Transportation Code § 311.008, the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas (“City Council”) may vacate, abandon, or close a street or alley of the City if a petition signed by all the owners of real property abutting the street or alley is submitted to the City Council; and

Whereas, the City Council has previously vacated, abandoned, and closed streets and alleys of the City on the petition of the owners or real property abutting the streets and alleys; and

Whereas, the City is experiencing increased growth and development within the City and anticipates the growth and development will continue; and

Whereas, City streets and alleys are essential to growth and development as they provide access to properties throughout the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Llano, Texas, hereby adopts a year moratorium on the vacation, abandonment, or closure of City streets and alleys. The moratorium shall remain in place until the City Council takes action to remove it.

Section 2. All resolutions, policies, practices, or guidelines inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, hereby repealed.
