

ORDINANCE NO. 1497

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, VACATING, ABANDONING, CLOSING, AND CONVEYING A PORTION OF BLUEBONNET STREET. THE PORTION OF BLUEBONNET STREET IS BETWEEN MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 21-22 & W PT 29 & E PT 30, MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 23,24 & E PT OF 29 & W 50 FT LT 28, AND MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 25 - 27 & LT 28 LESS W 50 FT. THIS STREET IS ADJACENT TO 200, 204, 206 SUNSET, AND 107 SUMMIT. THE PORTION OF THE STREET TO BE VACATED, ABANDONED, CLOSED, AND SOLD TO THE PETITIONER IS FURTHER DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND INCORPORATED HEREIN FOR ALL PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council recognizes that the petition duly presented to the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas to vacate, abandon, close, and convey a portion of Bluebonnet Street. The portion of Bluebonnet Street being vacated is located between Mountain View to the west and Summit to the East. These streets are adjacent to MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 25 - 27 & LT 28 LESS W 50 FT, MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 23,24 & E PT OF 29 & W 50 FT LT 28, MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 21-22 & W PT 29 & E PT 30, and MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 31-34. The portion of the street to be vacated, abandoned, closed, and sold to the Petitioner is further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The City of Llano has studied the requested abandonment in view of safety, health, and other considerations, and has determined that the public interest would be served if the request is approved.

SECTION 3. The Petitioner has agreed to pay fair market value for the land.


SECTION 4. Pursuant to the said abandonment request, from and after the effective date of this Ordinance, the portion of the street (16,200 square feet) described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes, shall be and the same is hereby vacated, abandoned, and closed, except regarding any existing utility lines and facilities, for which an easement shall be reserved by the City.

SECTION 5. The City Council authorizes the Mayor to execute the necessary documents to vacate, abandon, close, and convey an unimproved portion being Bluebonnet Street. The portion of Bluebonnet is between Mountain View to the west and Summit to the East. These streets are adjacent to MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 25 - 27 & LT 28 LESS W 50 FT, MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 23,24 & E PT OF 29 & W 50 FT LT 28, MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 21-22 & W PT 29 & E PT 30, and MOUNTAIN VIEW ESTATES LTS 31-34. The portion of the streets to be vacated, abandoned, closed, and sold to the Petitioner is further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 6. The City Council hereby finds that the above-described public right-of-way is not needed, except for the utility easement, and the City Council hereby deems that it is in the best interest of the public to vacate, abandon, close, and sell the Bluebonnet. The portion of Bluebonnet is between Mountain View to the west and Summit to the East. These streets are adjacent to 200, 204, 206 Sunset, AND 107 Summit.

The portion of the alleys and streets to be vacated, abandoned, closed, and sold to the Petitioner is further described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes.
