

RESOLUTION NO. R-2020-02

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS
EXTENDING THE DISASTER DECLARATION ISSUED BY MAYORAL
PROCLAMATION ON MARCH 13, 2020 IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 A PUBLIC
HEALTH EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, Mayor Gail Lang, Mayor of the City of Llano, Texas issued a mayoral proclamation declaring a local disaster for public health emergency for the City of Llano, in response to help prevent and control COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, a state of disaster for public health emergency shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of the City of Llano, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. The declaration of the Public Health Emergency, which was signed and executed by the Mayor on March 19, 2020, shall be renewed and continued through Tuesday, April 6, 2020 the City's next regularly scheduled meeting date, in accordance with section 418.108 of the Texas Government Code.


SECTION 3. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its date of adoption.


