

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-04-16-2

A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS EXPRESSING INTEREST AND DIRECTING STAFF TO FURTHER STUDY THE USE OF WASTE WATER EFFLUENT FOR BENEFICIAL PURPOSES AND POSSIBLE DISCHARGE; INVESTIGATING REGULATORY ISSUES; AND CONFERENCING WITH LEGAL STAFF AND STATE AGENCIES.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Llano, Texas is charged with investigating the most cost effective options for the operation of the City's utilities, and

WHEREAS, The Drought of 2011, and new treatment technologies have brought options to light that include treatment of effluent to higher quality that can be used for irrigation and discharge, and

WHEREAS, The City will be required to upgrade water storage facilities in the event effluent cannot be utilized for more beneficial purposes, and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Llano understands that the initial point of planning is consultation and investigation with Stakeholders, legal consultants and regulatory agencies.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Llano wishes to further investigate the beneficial uses of waste water effluent for irrigation and possible discharge; and further directs staff to provide additional information to Council including comments and concerns from other entities; regulatory processes; and costs.
