

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-09-03-1

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LLANO, TEXAS REQUESTING CONSIDERATION AND ESTABLISHING SUPPORT OF CREATING A DEDICATED CONTROLLED LEFT HAND TURN LANE AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF TEXAS STATE HIGHWAY 16 AND MAIN STREET AND TEXAS STATE HIGHWAY 16 AND SANDSTONE STREET IN LLANO TEXAS.**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Llano, Texas realize State Highway 16 is a portion of highway under the supervision and control of the Texas Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council have received requests from the merchants to review the current traffic flow; and

**WHEREAS**, the merchants have seen a need to create a more favorable area to disembark and enter vehicles parked on State Highway 16: and

**WHEREAS**, Merchants of and visitors to the Historic Downtown have of expressed a need for a dedicated controlled left hand turn lane; and

**WHEREAS**, the Llano City Council and staff have observed the reasons for the concerns expressed by the Llano merchants and visitors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council realize the need to establish a dedicated controlled left hand turn lane; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council understand that the creation of a dedicated left turn lane will reduce the through lanes to one north and one south in each direction.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL,**


1. That this Resolution is an official request of the elected body of the City of Llano to the appropriate representatives of the Texas Department of Transportation consider the placing of a dedicated left turn lane at the intersections of State Highway 16 and Main Street and state Highway 16 and Sandstone Street.
2. That the Mayor and City Council does support the request and possible decision to establish a dedicated left hand turn lane in the areas described.
