EXECUTIVE ORDER

July 11, 2011

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 1035 issued the 20th day of March 2006 and amended by Ordinance 1138 issued the 6th day of July 2009; the Mayor of the City of Llano, Texas has declared that certain emergency measures be taken; and

WHEREAS, the average daily discharge of the Llano River at Llano gauge is less than 12 cubic feet per second (cfs) triggering Stage 4- Severe Water Shortage Conditions.

NOW THEREFORE, Stage 4 Response – Critical Water Shortage Conditions

Water Use Restrictions: Under threat of penalty for violation, the following water use restrictions shall apply to all persons:

Goal: Limit the daily pumpage at the water treatment plant to 0.25 million gallons per day.


Water Use Restrictions: All requirements of Stage 3 shall remain in effect during Stage 4 except:

1. Irrigation of landscaped areas is absolutely prohibited with the exception of Saturday and Sunday watering can be done on designated day by means of a hand-held hose, a faucet-filled bucket or drip irrigation system only. The use of hose-end sprinklers or permanently installed automatic sprinkler systems are prohibited at all times.
2. Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, airplane or other vehicle is absolutely prohibited.
3. Filling or refilling of any pools and/or hot tubs is absolutely prohibited.
4. Commercial customers will remain in Stage III.
